



# Chevruta Style HMV

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# Chevruta H MV

- **Chevruta style H MV pays tribute to one of our earliest forms of Torah study**
- **Suitable for large or small groups**
- **Encourages in depth conversation**
- **Requires a fair degree of preparation**

# Chevruta HMV

- **Begin with a topic or theme**
- **Develop reading materials summarizing crucial information**
- **Discussion questions follow each reading passage**
- **Questions may start out easy and become more challenging**

# Chevruta HMV

- **Participants break into pairs**
- **Each pair reads a passage**
- **Allow 5-10 minutes per question for discussion**
- **After each question, facilitator encourages group sharing**

# Chevruta H MV

- **Participants then switch partners**
- **New pairs read the next passage and discuss the questions**
- **After 5-10 minutes, facilitator again encourages group sharing**
- **Continue with new pairs and passages to fill allotted time**

# Chevruta H MV

- **Topics may include:**
  - **Torah portion study**
  - **Current events**
  - **Religious or political concerns**
  - **Famous quotations**
  - **Literary or movie themes**
  - **Whatever you can imagine...**

# Chevruta H MV

- **Wrapping up is an important part**
- **Summarize what has been said**
- **Encourage participants to share impressions/what they learned**
- **Ask for other areas participants may want to discuss in the future**
